Children of all ages are invited to hunt for Easter eggs on the Town Church side lawn. BYOB – bring your own basket. Everyone is welcome!



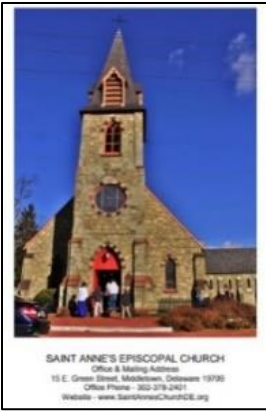
## **Rector's Office Hours – schedule time to meet with Russ**
