Volunteers Needed for Coffee Hour

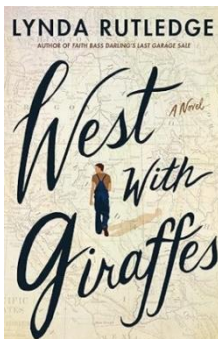


Kitchen Volunteers Needed




Food Bag Ministry
