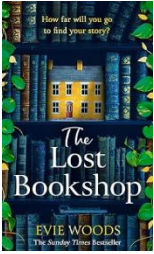
Sponsor a Sunday - Coffee Hour Refreshments


Food Bag Ministry
